

CAMP HILL MINI HUNTER TRIALS

Sun 21st May, Sun 4th June, Sun 9th July, Sun 27th August, Sun 17th Sept.

These Hunter Trials are designed to increase the confidence of both horse and rider. They can be used to help young riders, on or off the lead rein, develop their XC skills or help educate young horses by giving them a wide variety of obstacles that are small enough to trot over. Entries are on the day so if your first class goes well (and we sincerely hope it does) then you can always enter a slightly bigger one.

There is an all weather enclosed school which you are welcome to use to lunge or get on youngsters that may be finding life away from home a little too exciting!

Class 1 starts at 10 am.

This will be over an extended course and fences will be up to 2' 6" (80cm) high and include more difficult combinations and accuracy questions. Rosettes to 6 th

| Class 5 | Novice Hunter Trial | Entry fee | £17.00 |
| | Qualifier for Horseware National Hunter Trial Final at Eland Lodge
Same course as class 4. Rosettes to 10 th and prizes for the first three. Qualifying rosettes for first three competitors. | | |

The classes will be judged on an optimum time which will be based on a trot (220mpm) for the first class and a steady canter (325mpm) for class 2, 375mpm for classes 3, and 435mpm for 4 and 5.

Courses may be walked from 2pm the day before competition, or on the day if you prefer.
